**\*\*Students who fail the department's Theory Placement exam must take this class in Semester 1. Students who pass the placement must make up the missing 2 credits.**

**MUS 110/111/220/106/207 requirement is determined by placement exam.**

**\*It is strongly advised that students take one or two GEN ED courses during Intersessions to avoid a heavy credit load while student teaching. During Fall and Spring semesters, 12 credits of required coursework is necessary to maintain full time status for certain types of financial aid eligibility.**

**Students must take and receive a B or better in ENG 110 before being allowed to take any EDU courses. Students who receive less than a B or above in ENG 110 are subject to additional remedial coursework required by the Education Division.**

**Music Education majors must earn a C+ or higher in all required and related music coursework. Music Education majors must earn a B or higher in all required Music Education coursework. Music Education majors must earn a minimum GPA of 3.0 before taking EDU courses, and maintain a 3.0 or higher to continue through the degree program. Transfer students must have completed at least one full semester at Molloy College and achieved the minimum GPA of 3.0 to begin EDU coursework.**

**Music Education majors must successfully complete requirements for 7 semesters of Ensemble, 7 semesters of Music Education Seminar and 7 semesters of Recital Attendance to progress through the program. (Transfer student requirements may be adjusted appropriately at the department's discretion).**

**To fulfill the Ensemble requirement, Music Education majors must register for an assigned ensemble each semester that directly relates to their primary instrument or voice. Students will have the option of taking an ensemble for (0-1 credit), depending on the semester.**

**To fulfill the Applied Music requirement, Music Education majors must register for the section that directly relates to their primary instrument or voice. This is designated by the department.**

**MUS 209 and MUS 109 are strongly recommended as Music History Electives.**
